

2026 NSHSRA & NSJHSRA Rodeo Royalty Contest

Events and Dress Requirements

Outfit #1:

ORIENTATION

WRITTEN TEST

INTERVIEW

Queen – Cinch/Cruel Girl Outfit (embellishments can be added)

Princess – Same outfit as Horsemanship – Cinch/Cruel girl jeans and Cinch/Cruel Girl western long sleeve shirt. Blue jeans and plain white blouse. No embellishments

WRITTEN TEST - Each contestant will be spaced apart for the test. A Proctor will read the questions for the test to all contestants. After all questions have been read, the contestants will be provided extra time for silence if they would prefer to test in silence. The test will be based on the 2024-2026 NHSRA Rulebook. The test will consist of 50 questions (17 true/false: 17 multiple choice and 16 fill-ins). Each question is worth ½ (.50) points.

Outfit #2:

HORSEMANSHIP

(Represent your sponsor – Cinch/Cruel Girl jeans and Cinch/Cruel Girl western long sleeve shirt are **REQUIRED**. Attire will be blue denim jeans and a plain white cotton blouse or shirt. **PLEASE NOTE:** Blouse or shirt is to be **PLAIN**. No ruffles, accessories, tuxedo shirt or other fancy styles are not allowed.

Tack – split reins are not **REQUIRED**. Tie-downs, spurs, matching blanket/leg wraps and blinged headstall/breast collars are optional.

INTRODUCTIONS

IMPROPTU

(Contestants have the option of wearing suits, dresses, skirts, blouses, dress pants. Jeans and long sleeve shirts. Leather dresses are **NOT** required. 1 inch collars on dress is optional). **NOTE: JHS contestants will have the option to wear a dress/skirt. Or they can wear western attire (jeans and long sleeve shirt) of their choosing.**

INTRODUCTION – Girl to introduce herself – 10 second time limit.

IMPROMPTU – this will be one question that is asked of each contestant.

SPEECH – contestant is to speak about her country, state or providence or on anything with a western theme. Speech is 2 minutes in length.

PHOTO- 1 color VERTICAL 8x10 head and shoulders shot **ONLY**.

*If you are currently in and finishing this year 9th-11th grades, you may run for the high school Queen title.

*If you are currently in and finishing this year 6-8th grade you may run for the jr high school Princess title.
